Job Title: Commissioning Engineer
Reports To: Operations Manager

Main Purpose

Supporting all machines and tooling either on our own premises or that of our customers, including commissioning of all new machines.

Main Tasks (After initial Training)

- Commission all new machines including installation.
- Set up and test new tooling as required.
- Maintain close relationships with customers including after care service of machines when installation is complete.
- Train customer's operators on site.
- Provide telephone advice and assistance to all customers.
- Fault find and rectify all machine issues.
- Offer solutions to machine difficulties.
- Carry out service and maintenance of machines as required.
- Operate to existing Quality procedures in particular commissioning documentation.
- Report fully all actions on site.
- Ability to understand written and verbal instructions.
- Be familiar with the required Health & Safety standards governing your job.
- Maintain polite and good communication with your colleagues at all time.
- Be prepared to undertake other reasonable duties as required.
